

Montessori Supply list.

ACCORDING TO STATE REGULATIONS EVERYTHING NEEDS TO HAVE YOUR CHILD'S NAME IN A VISIBLE CLEAR WAY.

A **canvas bag** about 14" x 16". Large enough to hold their folder, slippers, hats and mittens. Canvas totes (no zippers, snaps or draw-strings) can be found at local craft stores like Hobby Lobby, Michaels, Joann's, or ordered online. Have your child decorate it, and PLEASE LABEL IT WITH THEIR NAME ON THE OUTSIDE FRONT AND BACK. There are several of the same brand/designs, so names are very important.

2 cylinders or packets of hand wipes (NO CLOROX)- Here are some brand names that are safe for us to use and accepted by the Early Department of Education:

1. Boogie Hands, Antibacterial Hand Wipes
 2. Babyanics Alcohol-Free Hand Sanitizer Wipes
 3. Care Touch Alcohol-Free Hand Sanitizing Wipes
- (or any other alcohol free ones)

1 folder with pockets

1 big Tissue box

1 roll of paper towel.

If your child is 3 years-old: **1 box of large crayons** (no thin ones please)

If your child is 4 years-old: **1 set of 4 tubs of play dough.**

A **water bottle** with your CHILD'S NAME ON IT.

A **change of clothes** in a Ziploc bag with your CHILD'S NAME ON IT.

A **small plastic container** (snack cubby is 4Wx6Hx8D) with a snack. Even if snack is individually wrapped they need to be in a container with your CHILD'S NAME ON IT.

For full-day students:

A **lunchbox** with your CHILD'S NAME ON IT. Lunch box **with handles** please.

Children have to carry them outside to recess and during winter time it's hard to hold lunchbox and water bottle with mittens on.
